The Pavement, a unique UK-wide magazine for a homeless readership, is looking for reporters, writers and photographers who can contribute to our monthly magazine, which aims to bring them coverage of the issues that matter.

We're looking for people who are already skilled and are happy to work from home in or around London, the West Midlands, Glasgow or Edinburgh, where our magazines are distributed. While there may be some an option to work for the offices of a partner organisation, you should have your own laptop or computer. We'll be there to offer lots of support by phone, Skype or during face-to-face meetings and training sessions, but you'll also need to be able to work on your own initiative too.

We're looking for someone who can commit to working on one–three stories per month on a voluntary basis.

About you

We're looking for people who have experience of reporting or photojournalism: we are a very small team and need people who can work independently.

You'll have knowledge or an interest in the causes of homelessness and want to find out more.

You'll also be able to commit for a period of six months and be able to meet deadlines for the website and our print edition.

About The Pavement

The Pavement is a unique UK-wide magazine for a homeless readership. Our volunteer journalists cover the news from, or affecting, the streets, and we often feature stories not seen in the mainstream press. Each copy also features The List, a regularly updated directory of homeless services, as well as cartoons, opinion pieces and more.

Though we deliver over 7,000 free copies to hostels, homeless charities, projects and libraries each month in four of the UK's largest cities, we receive no statutory funding, and rely entirely on donations and grants from small trusts.
