Have you got fiendishly good fundraising skills? Do you want to use them to support a unique small charity working to support homeless people across the UK?

The Pavement, a unique UK-wide magazine for a homeless readership, is looking for a fundraising assistant to work with us on a voluntary basis and help us make our organisation more sustainable as we approach our 10th anniversary.

This is a varied role, and you'll be involved in all aspects of fundraising from helping to offer assistance to our fabulous supporters who raise money for us in all sorts of ways, to helping to identify and complete funding applications for essential costs such as printing and delivery.

You'll be happy to work from home, and while there may be some an option to work for the offices of a partner organisation, you should have your own laptop or computer. We'll be there to offer lots of support by phone, Skype or during face-to-face meetings and training sessions, but you'll need to be able to work on your own initiative too.

We're looking for someone who can commit to about eight hours every week, ideally for a six-month period.

About you

We're looking for someone who is organised and able to prioritise their own workload. We are a very small team, so we're looking for someone who can work quite independently.

You'll need some experience of writing funding applications and have communication skills.

You'll have knowledge or an interest in the causes of homelessness and want to find out more.

About The Pavement

The Pavement is a unique UK-wide magazine for a homeless readership. Our volunteer journalists cover the news from, or affecting, the streets, and we often feature stories not seen in the mainstream press. Each copy also features The List, a regularly updated directory of homeless services, as well as cartoons, opinion pieces and more.

Though we deliver over 7,000 free copies to hostels, homeless charities, projects and libraries each month in four of the UK's largest cities, we receive no statutory funding and rely entirely on donations and grants from small trusts.
